All staff have put forth significant effort into building balanced classrooms and we ask that you trust our professional judgment in this matter.

### **School Hours and Lunch**

Students can access their classrooms starting at 8:15 am, with the first bell ringing at 8:25 am and the second bell at 8:30 am, when classes begin. Students arriving after 8:30 am <u>must</u> check in at the office. Morning recess is from 10:30-10:45 am. Lunch begins at 12:05 pm, when K-6 students eat lunch in their classrooms and then go outside until the bell rings at 12:55 pm. **BES is a nut-free school.** Grades 7 & 8 students may leave school grounds for lunch <u>with parent permission</u>, signed digitally each year as part of the Annual Demographic Form which will be sent out on Tuesday August 29, 2023. **We ask that Grades 7 & 8 students bring a lunch and remain on school grounds for lunch until Wednesday August 30** to allow time for parents to fill out the form online. School is dismissed at 3:02 pm (12:05 on half-day Fridays).

## Parking and Drop Off Zones

If you drive your child(ren) to school, please <u>click here</u> to take a close look at the map regarding the recommended traffic flow and drop-off/pick-up **Kiss & Go** locations. Squirrel St between Moose St and Elk St is **closed to all traffic** except buses from 8:15-8:30 am and 3:00-3:15 pm. Kiss & Go zones are designed to safely pick up and drop off students. There are two Kiss & Go zones; Elk Street and Big Horn Street. Please use these as intended; kiss your child good-bye and move along! Drivers, please do not leave your vehicle parked or idling in this area for any amount of time. Please also be respectful of the handicap zones.

# Bus Safety: Morning Drop Off and Afternoon Pick Up



Across Canada it is the law that vehicles **must not pass** a School Bus when the **Red Lights** on the bus are flashing and the **Stop Sign** is visible to drivers. BES needs all families who drop or pick up their child(ren) to follow this law to ensure the safety of students coming and going from school each day. Bylaw and RCMP will be regularly supporting the school to enforce this law to ensure safety. Administration is outside and active every day in the morning and afternoon to work with families, community members and visitors to adhere to this law. Please do your part to ensure the safety of our students - it is everyone's responsibility!

#### **School Bus Services**

Kindergarten through Grade 8 students may use the bus if they live close to a current CRPS school bus stop. You must register for the bus and get a bus pass if you have not been on the bus before. #### **Before School Care**

Before School Care is being offered at no cost to families in need of childcare before school to enable parents to get to work on time. Before School Care will commence Tuesday, August 29 and registration is required each year. It is available between 7:45 - 8:15 am. Please <u>click here</u> to register your child. Students who arrive at 8:15 do not need to register for the Before School Care Program.

#### **School Fees**

As part of the CRPS budgeting process for the 2023-2024 school year, the Board of Trustees has advised that it will remove the BES lunch supervision fee of \$140, beginning next year. The decision to remove this fee reflects the Alberta government's six percent increase in base funding to all school authorities for the upcoming school year, a revenue source the board would like to pass on to families. Incidental fees will be added to your Parent Portal account if required.
