

Host a High School Student for CRPS International Student Program.

CRPS International Student Program continues to be sought after - pandemic or not - and through hard work this past summer and fall, CRPS has developed a solid COVID readiness plan, including how to receive international students safely. This has allowed us to receive about 25 students this winter - and we have a full roster of about 50 incoming 2021-2022 international students arriving at CRPS in the fall!



We are accepting applications for host families for 5 or 10 month commitments. Students from the following countries will be with us next school year: Spain, Germany, Finland, Japan, Italy, Switzerland, Austria, Czech Republic, Mexico.

A rigorous COVID readiness plan is in place to keep our host families and communities safe. Students either arrive into hotel quarantine for 14 days or have an opportunity to participate in the airport rapid testing program and get released from hotel quarantine into homestay after one or

two negative test results. All this after having a negative test result prior to boarding the plane to Canada.

We have amazing students coming our way - outdoor enthusiasts, musicians, skiers (both cross-country as well as downhill), students interested in art, film-making...and all of them have a few things in common - they want to improve their English, attend school and experience life in the Canadian Rockies by living with a local Canadian host family.
